Information provided per the Board request made during discussion in the 2013 contract negotiations

Man-hours for alarms: November 2015

22 alarms during the month. 94 man-hours on alarms. Total alarm hours 94.

Man-hours in house training

MFD conducted 2 in-house drills of 2 hours or more. 44 man-hours of in house training. Total in house training hours 44.

Man-hours for outside training

None.

Man-hours NYS training courses

Auto Vehicle Extrication Training. Three of our members participated in this state fire class two times a week for two weeks. 36 man-hours total. This will finish next month.

Man-hours vehicle inspections and maintenance by members

It took 10 members 3 hours for the monthly cleaning and inspection of the apparatus. Total maintenance time 30 hours.

Station maintenance

House duties of cleaning the kitchen, restroom, office areas and meeting room. 24 man Hours.

Station items needing maintenance

The building committee met this month with the United States Department of Agriculture to inquire about station funding. They basically only offer low interest rate loans and not much grant funding at this time. We will be inquiring about a private engineering firm to audit the station for NFPA deficiencies in 2016. We are currently holding off on the hot water heater as we have it working properly at this time.
